

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Free Swimming Programme will operate from the 1st April 2015.
2. The scheme is only available to residents of Portsmouth who live at an address in the City boundary where council tax is paid to Portsmouth City Council. Proof of address will be required during the registration process (copy of utility or council tax bill will be accepted).
3. To be able to register for Free Swimming the applicant must have a valid Portsmouth Library Service card, which must be presented together with this form on registering. Successful applicants will be issued with a Free Swimming Membership Card. A one off administration charge of £3.50 applies. Please note there will be a charge of £3.50 for any replacement cards.
4. Free swimming is only available for children aged 12 years and under. Other memberships are available from all participating centres.
5. Free Swimming will only be available during designated free swimming sessions. Please see programme for further details, or visit our website.
6. Children between the ages of 5 and 12 years will not be permitted access to any free swimming during the hours of 9am and 3pm during school term times.
7. Parkwood Community Leisure reserve the right to refuse free swimming entry if in their opinion the customer does not fall within the age requirements of the scheme. Proof of age may be requested. For customers that might fall within this category forms of identification that will be accepted include valid passport, or birth certificate. Please ensure appropriate proof of age is brought with you to avoid any disappointment.
8. Admission to the Free Swimming sessions will be subject to the Pool's capacity.
9. Depending on demand usage may be restricted at certain times and the pool programme may be subject to change without notice.
10. Children under 16 years of age will not be permitted into a Centre after 8.00pm unless accompanied by an adult.
11. All children under the age of 8, must be accompanied in the Pool by an adult at all times to the ratio of 1 parent to 3 children. For children under the age of 4 a ratio of 1 parent to 2 children applies.
12. Children under the age of 3 must wear aqua nappies / pants while swimming at all times.
13. Parkwood Community Leisure reserve the right to refuse free swimming entry if in their opinion the conduct of an individual is inappropriate or objectionable.
14. Customers are expected to use all facilities and equipment in an appropriate manner and give proper regard to both their own Health & Safety and that of others.
15. Lockers are provided for both personal belongings and valuables for use within the Centre and you are encouraged to use these facilities. However, the Centre cannot accept responsibility for any theft or losses incurred during your visit.
16. If individuals fail to comply with these terms and conditions, then Parkwood Community Leisure reserve the right to refuse free admission or ask those individuals to leave the premises.
17. Portsmouth City Council reserve the right to withdraw this scheme at anytime.

### WHAT IS THE FREE SWIMMING PROGRAMME?

The Free Swimming Programme is a Portsmouth City Council initiative designed to extend the opportunities to swim and maximise the health benefits of wider participation in swimming. It is only available for residents of Portsmouth and proof of address will be required e.g. copy of a utility or Council Tax bill. A one off administration charge of £3.50 will be payable on registration.

The Free Swimming Programme will commence on the 1st April 2015.

In trying to encourage use of the City Council's Cultural Services, to be able to benefit from this free swimming initiative applicants will be required to have a valid Portsmouth Library Service card.
