Adoption Statement

Town & Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

1. This statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 11(2) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012. It gives notice that Portsmouth City Council formally adopted the Seafront Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 10th April 2013.
2. There have been modifications to the SPD pursuant to section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. These are set out in a report to the city council's Cabinet and report summarising responses to public consultation on the draft plan (see paragraph 4).
3. A person with sufficient interest in the decision of the City Council to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision to adopt the document. The application must be made to the High Court in a prompt manner and in any event not later than three months following the date of adoption given in paragraph 1.
4. The Cabinet report, Seafront SPD, summary of responses to public consultation, Sustainability Appraisal report and Habitats Regulations Assessment can all be viewed on the council's website (www.portsmouth.gov.uk/living/25964.html) or at the Civic Offices, Guildhall Square during normal office hours (Monday-Thursday 8.30-17.00, and Friday 8.30-16.00).
