**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (UNIVERSITY OF PORTSMOUTH CAR PARKS)
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES AMENDMENTS) (NO.44) ORDER 2016**

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 32, 33, 34 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect would be to amend existing parking arrangements within 3 parking sites owned and managed by the University of Portsmouth.

- Blue Badge holders are exempt from the restrictions and charges, provided the Blue Badge is clearly displayed in the front windscreen in addition to a valid University of Portsmouth permit
- All marked loading bays and drop-off bays located within the parking areas below are subject to a 30-minute waiting time
- Bays marked for specific vehicles may only be used by the class of vehicle specified
- During the Pay & Display operating times, the parking charge is £2.00

**A) PAY & DISPLAY MONDAY TO FRIDAY 5PM – 8AM, ALL DAY AT WEEKENDS AND BANK HOLIDAYS.
VALID PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY AT ALL OTHER TIMES.**
