

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) (NO. 127) ORDER 2017

17 November 2017: Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 32, 35 and 36 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect would be as follows:

A) DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAYS* (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH)

* Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at these locations.
