

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (LB ZONE) (RESIDENTS' PARKING PLACES AND PERMIT ENTITLEMENT) (NO.128) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 10 April 2018 made the above order under section 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the 1984 Act'), as amended, and parts III and IV of schedule 9 to the 1984 Act. The order comes into operation on 24 April 2018, to effect:
