

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (MAGDALEN ROAD) (FOOTWAY ALTERATIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (NO.14) ORDER 2018

The Portsmouth City Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council"), in exercise of its powers under sections 1-4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act'), as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and in accordance with Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this order.
2. The Order specified in Schedule 1 shall have effect subject to the amendments specified below the said Order of the said Schedule.
3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by or under any other enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council (Magdalen Road) (Footway Alterations and Amendments to Waiting Restrictions) (No.14) Order 2018 and shall come into operation on the 26 November 2018.

AMENDMENT TO EXISTING ORDER

1. The Portsmouth City Council (Consolidated) (On-Street Parking and Restrictions on Waiting and Loading) (No. 6) Order 2015

a) Amend Items 744 (a) (i) and (b) (i) in Schedule 1 relating to Magdalen Road to read:

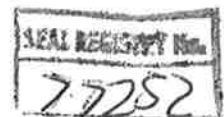
- (a) (i) The south side from its junction with Northern Parade in an easterly direction for a distance of 19 metres**
- (b) (i) The north side from its junction with Northern Parade in an easterly direction for a distance of 11 metres**

CITY COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR THE ORDER

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of such danger arising;
- For preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road;
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs;
- For any of the purposes specified in s.87(1)(a-c) of the Environment Act 1995 (air quality);
- To reduce the risk of road traffic collisions by providing a clear place to cross the road
- Increase pedestrian confidence in the infrastructure - potentially encouraging more walking to school;
- Improve accessibility for all pedestrians;
- Slow traffic speeds entering Magdalen Road.
