

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VILLIERS ROAD: PART) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC)
(NO 20) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2016**

The Portsmouth City Council (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council'), in exercise of the powers under Sections 1 - 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act'), as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act"), the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
2. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to proceed past the point specified in relation to the road in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the road and length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 shall apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle to be used in an emergency for Police, Fire & Rescue or Ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a mechanical road sweeper.
5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by or under any enactment.
6. This Order may be cited as The Portsmouth City Council (Villiers Road: Part) (One-Way Traffic) (No 20) Order 2016 and shall come into operation on the 24 March 2016.

CITY COUNCIL'S REASON FOR MAKING THE ORDER

This Order makes permanent the provisions of ETRO 2/2015 (an experimental order), which enabled Villiers Road to be reopened to vehicular traffic through to Palmerston Road, facilitating a westbound direction of travel on the section of Villiers Road between The Vale and the access to Palm Court car park. The closure point installed when Palmerston Road was closed to all traffic is no longer required now that northbound travel is possible.
