

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VICTORY BUSINESS CENTRE) (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (NO.27) ORDER 2017

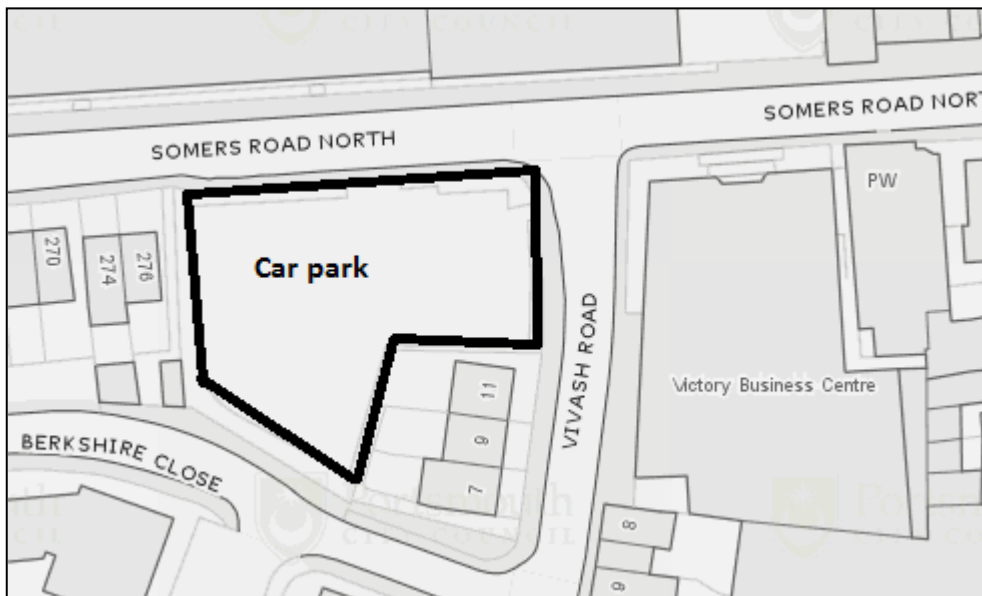
Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 28 June 2017 made the above Order under Sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order comes into operation on 12 July 2017 and the effect will be to restrict parking within a council-owned car park as follows:

A) VICTORY BUSINESS CENTRE PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY: 7AM - 6PM MONDAY TO FRIDAY (excluding Bank Holidays)

1. Name of Parking Place

Victory Business Centre car park

(Accessed from the south side of Somers Road North, Fratton)



2. Other provisions

- Disabled Blue Badge holders are not exempt, and would be required to display their badge in addition to a Victory Business Centre permit
- Permits will be available to Victory Business Centre staff at a monthly charge

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 28 June 2017 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
