(ONE WAY TRAFFIC: AMENDMENTS TO CYCLING PROVISIONS) (NO.36) ORDER 2017**

17 March 2017: Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 1-4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect would be as follows:
