

**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND AMENDMENTS) (NO. 38B) ORDER 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 22 August 2017 made the above Order under Sections 32, 35 and 36 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order comes into operation on 5 September 2017 and the effect will be as follows:

**A) DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING BAY\* (MINIMUM 5-METRE LENGTH)**

\* Only vehicles displaying a Blue Badge or relevant permit issued by the Council may park at this location.

Warblington St (alongside no. 2 South Normandy)

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 22 August 2017 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
