

## **THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (ANGLESEA ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF LEFT HAND TURN) (NO 55) ORDER 2017**

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council on 23 May 2018 made the above order under sections 1-4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991, and the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996. The order comes into operation on 6 June 2018 and the effect will be as follows:

### **A) PROHIBITION OF LEFT HAND TURN**

#### **1. Anglesea Road**

Vehicles not permitted to turn left into Park Road from Anglesea Road.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 23 May 2018 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
