

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (SOUTHSEA SEAFRONT) (LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (NO.56) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 22 June 2017 made the above Order under sections 1 – 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order comes into operation on 6 July 2017 and the effect will be as follows:

**A) CHANGE FROM POLICE BAY, TO:
LOADING ONLY 8AM - 6PM**

1. South Parade

South side, the 15m length west of South Parade Pier

**B) CHANGE FROM 24-HOUR LOADING ONLY, TO:
LOADING ONLY 8AM - 6PM**

1. South Parade

South side, the 15m length west of South Parade Pier (to become a single bay with A1 above)

2. Southsea Esplanade

South side, the 30m length east of South Parade Pier

C) LOADING ONLY 7AM - 9PM

1. South Parade

North side, east of Clarendon Road - within a new loading area to be constructed in conjunction with the adjacent housing/retail development as per Planning consent.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 22 June 2017 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
