

## **THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (FRATTON WAY) (TAXI RANKS) (NO.59) ORDER 2018**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 23 August 2018 made the above Order under sections 1-4 and part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the 1984 Act'), as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of schedule 9 to the 1984 Act. The order comes into operation on 5 September 2018 to effect:

### **A) CHANGE FROM BUS STOP CLEARWAY TO: NO STOPPING AT ANY TIME EXCEPT TAXIS**

#### **1. Fratton Way**

- (a) The west side, the 37-metre length south of the access road to the Tesco superstore
- (b) The east side, the 32-metre length south of the access road to the Tesco superstore

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 23 August 2018 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
