THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (DUISBURG WAY) (AMENDMENTS TO WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (NO.63) ORDER 2016

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1 – 4 and 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect would be as follows:

A) REMOVAL OF PAY & DISPLAY AND RELOCATION OF BUS STOP CLEARWAY FOR: INSTALLATION OF TOUCAN CROSSING (signalised pedestrian and cycle crossing)

1. Duisburg Way

The southwest side approximately 95 metres south-east of Pier Road roundabout, linking the Southsea Common pathways to the north and south

- reduction of Pay & Display parking by 46m overall (8 spaces)
- relocation of bus stop clearway north-westwards by 37m to accommodate the crossing
