

The Portsmouth City Council (Castle Road Autumn Bazaar) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No.68) Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order will be in operation between the hours of 0600 to 2300 from **Saturday 24th to Sunday 25th September 2016** and the effect will be as follows:

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING

ROADS TO BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC	Length of road
1. CASTLE ROAD	From its junction with Regents Place to 100 metres north to entrance to Portsmouth High school.

B) ALTERNATIVE ROUTES FOR TRAFFIC

Traffic will be diverted onto Southsea Terrace, along Bellevue Terrace, along Jubilee Terrace and into Hambrook Street and vice versa. Diversions to Great Southsea Street will continue along Kings Terrace onto Kings Road and into Castle Road.

C) REASON FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The Order is required to allow for the event to take place on the highway.
