

THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (CHARLES DICKENS STREET) (AMENDMENTS TO WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (NO.77) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council on 23 August 2018 made the above Order under sections 1 – 4 and 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the 1984 Act'), as amended, and in accordance with parts III and IV of schedule 9 to the 1984 Act. The order comes into operation on 5 September 2018, to effect:

A) RELOCATION OF LOADING ONLY BAY

1. Charles Dickens Street

North side, relocate eastwards of its current position by 23m, to outside the new bin access and goods in entrance (incorporating both dropped kerbs), in place of the Pay & Display

B) AMENDMENT TO PAY & DISPLAY BAY:

1. Charles Dickens Street

(a) North side, relocate westwards into the previous 9m length of the loading only bay

(b) North side, extend 4m eastwards in place of double yellow lines to enable the remaining parking bay to accommodate 2 vehicles (relocated loading bay leaves parking space for 1.5 vehicles)

These amendments are required to accommodate the adjacent redevelopment of the former Chaucer House site into student accommodation and ground floor businesses

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 23 August 2018 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
