

**The Portsmouth City Council (Castle Road Christmas Festival) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No.80) Order 2016**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Portsmouth City Council, the Highway Authority, intends to make the above Order under Section 16(a) and 16 (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Portsmouth City Council is satisfied that traffic on the said roads should be prohibited for the purpose of holding events on the highway and proposes to make an Order, the effect of which is that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait along the lengths of road listed in Schedule (i) of the full Order. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Emergency vehicles will also be accommodated at all times. The proposed Order will be operative at the times shown on the schedules to this Notice.

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to the arrangements above intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding or waiting in the roads and the lengths of roads set out below on **Saturday 3rd December and Sunday 4th December 2016**.
