**THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (WICKHAM STREET AND CLOCK STREET
- VICTORIAN FESTIVAL OF CHRISTMAS) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
DRIVING, WAITING AND LOADING) (NO 90) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016**

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order will be in operation between **Friday 25th November and Sunday 27th November 2016** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING

WICKHAM STREET

In its entirety.

B) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

ADMIRALTY ROAD (NORTHBOUND) From Queen Street to Bonfire Corner.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES FOR TRAFFIC

Traffic will be diverted via Cross Street and Bonfire Corner for access to the Portsmouth Historic Dockyard car park.

C) REASON FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The Order is required to reduce the disruption to traffic likely to be caused by the Victorian Festival of Christmas event which takes place in the Historic Dockyard.
