THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (ISAMBARD BRUNEL ROAD AND CHARLES DICKENS STREET PHASE 2) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, WAITING AND LOADING) (NO.96) TEMPORARY ORDER 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation on 08 December 2016 and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Isambard Brunel Road

Subway Closed at junction with Alec Rose Lane and Greetham Street.

New pedestrian crossing facility crossing point built on Isambard Brunel Road opposite Charter Academy School.

B) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING

Charles Dickens Street

100m from its junction with Alec Rose Lane on both sides of the carriageway to the rear of Chaucer House.

C) REASON FOR THE ORDER

The Order is required to facilitate development works of Chaucer House.

D) DURATION OF THE ORDER

The Order will be in operation from 8th December 2016 to last for 18 months or upon completion of the works, whichever is sooner.

A copy of the Temporary Order and a plan may be examined at the Information Desk, Ground Floor, Civic Offices, and Portsmouth during normal office hours.
