## THE PORTSMOUTH (NO.1 - (2019: ADDITION OF A RESTRICTED BYWAY)) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2019

The above order, made on 21 February 2019, if confirmed as made, will modify the Portsmouth City Council definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them a restricted byway from Trimmer's Court at junction with East Street, proceeding northwards round quayside edge, progressing south along water's edge to the Bridge Tavern, turning west along inner Camber basin quayside edge to southern end of Trimmer's Court.

A copy of the order and the order map may be seen free of charge at Portsmouth City Council, Civic Offices, Guildhall Square, Portsmouth, PO1 2PX from 9am to 4:30pm Monday to Friday (excluding public holidays). Copies of the order and map may be bought from there at the price of £1.00.

Any representation or objection relating to the order must be sent in writing to Michael Lawther, City Solicitor, Portsmouth City Council, Civic Offices, Guildhall Square, Portsmouth, PO1 2PX not later than 12 April 2019, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, Portsmouth City Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State (in whole or in part), any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
