**Portsmouth City Council (Pedal Portsmouth Glow Ride) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Waiting and Loading) (No.100) Order 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16A and 16B of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **14<sup>th</sup> October 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, WAITING AND LOADING**

SOUTHSEA ESPLANADE	From the junction of St Helen's Parade to the junction of St George's Road (except for disable access east to lamppost No. 28 opposite Canoe Lake).
EASTNEY ESPLANADE	From the junction of St George's Road to lamppost No. 10 at the junction of the entry road to Royal Marines Museum.
ST GEORGE'S ROAD	From the junction of Eastern Parade to its junction with Eastney Esplanade.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate the Pedal Portsmouth Glow Ride.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

From 14<sup>th</sup> October 2017 from 1600 to 2030 or completion of the event, whichever is sooner.

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted from Southsea Esplanade to St Helen's Parade to Eastern Parade and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
