**Portsmouth City Council (Portsmouth Triathlon) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving)  
(No.107) Order 2019**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16A and 16B of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019 and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

CLARENCE ESPLANADE	From the flood gates (west) to its junction with South Parade.
SOUTH PARADE	From its junction with The Dell to its junction with Southsea Esplanade.
THE DELL	In its entirety.
SOUTHSEA ESPLANADE	From its junction with South Parade to its junction with St George's Road (Eastney).
EASTNEY ESPLANADE	From its junction with St George's Road to the Yomper Memorial.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate the Portsmouth Triathlon event.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

From Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019 for 1 day or completion of the event, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above the closure will be in place from 07:00 to 11:00.

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted from Duisburg way, Clarence Parade, St Helens Parade, Eastern Parade, St George's Road, Cromwell Road and Henderson road and vice versa.  
Pedestrian access will be maintained.
