**Portsmouth City Council (Pedal Portsmouth Glow Ride) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Waiting and Loading) (No.110) Order 2018**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **10<sup>th</sup> November 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING**

AVENUE DE CAEN

In its entirety.

CLARENCE ESPLANADE

From its junction with Pier Road to its junction with Jack Cockerill Way (west of the entrance to The Pyramids car park).

JACK COCKERILL WAY

In its entirety.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate the Pedal Portsmouth Glow Ride event around a one-way clockwise circular route.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

From 10th November 2018 for 1 day or completion of the event, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above the closure will be in place from 07:30 to 19:30.

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted from Jack Cockerill Way to Clarence Parade to Duisburg Way to Pier Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Cyclists diverted westbound from Ladies Mile at its junction with Jack Cockerill Way to Clarence Esplanade. Cyclists should travel in the direction of the Pedal Portsmouth Glow Ride (southbound on Jack Cockerill Way, westbound on Clarence Esplanade and eastbound from the Pier Road gyratory). Please follow Glow Ride signage.
