Portsmouth City Council (Dorking Crescent) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving (Eastbound)) (No.113) Order 2018

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **12th November 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING (EASTBOUND)

DORKING CRESCENT

From the junction of Widley Court Drive to Magdala Road westbound.

B) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND WAITING

DORKING CRESCENT

At the rear of 63 – 81 Cosham High Street for 45 meters on Dorking Crescent.

Opposite Broad Reach to 73 on Dorking Crescent.

C) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the introduction of a one way diversion for development works at Myfanwy House.

D) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 12th November 2018 for 18 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner.

E) DIVERSION

No Entry at westbound junction of Dorking Crescent and Magdala Road. Vehicles diverted from Magdala Road (west) to east junction with Dorking Crescent. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
