**The Portsmouth City Council (100th Anniversary of Women's Royal Naval Service)
(Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No. 117) Order 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from 8am - 4pm on **4th November 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, WAITING AND LOADING

ST THOMAS'S STREET	From the junction of Oyster Street to Lombard Street.

C) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the event.

D) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 8am - 4pm on 4th November 2017 or completion of the event, whichever is sooner.

E) DIVERSION

Vehicles diverted from Lombard Street to High Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Any vehicles removed from the prohibited areas above will be relocated to Victoria Avenue Spur.
