**Portsmouth City Council (Burnaby Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting)  
(No.124) Order 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **6<sup>th</sup> December 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING**

BURNABY ROAD

North of the bridge for 10 metres.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate tree works and scaffolding works as preparation for bridge replacement works.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

From 6<sup>th</sup> December 2017 for 3 nights and 2 days or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, the works are expected to be carried out from 22:00 to 06:00 each night on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> December then from 00:05 on 26<sup>th</sup> December through to 23:00 on 27<sup>th</sup> December 2017.

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted from Burnaby Road, St James's Road, Queen Street, The Hard, Ordnance Road, and Park Road, Angelsea Road, Queens Street, St James's Road. Pedestrians will be diverted from Park Road to Ordnance Row, Butcher Street, St Georges Square, Britain Street, St George's Way, Richmond Place, Portland Street and vice versa.
