Portsmouth City Council (Landport Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.127) Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991.

The Order comes into operation from **21st October 2019** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

LANDPORT STREET

From its junction with Crasswell Street to its junction with Australia Close.

From its junction with Australia Close to its junction with Arundel Street.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate water main works.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 21st October 2019 for 4 weeks or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, the works will take place over two phases: Crasswell Street to Australia Close from 21/10/19 to 08/11/19, then Australia Close to Arundel Street from 04/11/19 to 15/11/19.

D) DIVERSION

Australia Close to Crasswell Street closure:

Vehicles will be diverted from Australia Close, Buriton Street, Crasswell Street.

Australia Street to Arundel Street closure:

Vehicles will be diverted from Australia Close, Buriton Street, Crasswell Street, Charles Street, A2030 Lake Road, A2030 Holbrook Road, Arundel Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
