**The Portsmouth City Council (Copnor Walking Nativity) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) (No.132) Order 2017**

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the roads and the lengths of roads set out below on **Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2017**.

**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING (ROLLING CLOSURE)**

From 16.00 to 17.00, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary. Roads will reopen when it is deemed safe to do so.

**1. EPWORTH ROAD**

From its junction with Copnor Road to its junction with Kensington Road.

**2. KENSINGTON ROAD**

From its junction with Epworth Road to its junction with Copythorn Road.

**3. COPYTHORN ROAD**

From its junction with Kensington Road to its junction with Lyndhurst Road.

**4. LYNDHURST ROAD**

From its junction with Copythorn Road to its junction with Kirby Road.

**5. KIRBY ROAD**

From its junction with Lyndhurst Road to its junction with Kensington Road.

**6. KENSINGTON ROAD**

From its junction with Kirby Road to its junction with Mayfield Road.

**REASON FOR THE ORDER**

The above restrictions are necessary for the safe passage of the Copnor Walking Nativity.

**DIVERSION**

A rolling road closure will be in place. Traffic will be diverted ahead of the parade or will follow the parade and roads will be re-opened when considered safe to do so.
