The Portsmouth City Council (Eastern Road) (Northbound carriageway) (No. 14) Temporary Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council has made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation on 1 April 2016 and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

EASTERN ROAD

Northbound carriageway from its junction with Anchorage Road to its junction with the Farlington Roundabout/A27.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

The Order is required to facilitate defence work along the Eastern Road bridge.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

The Order will be in operation for up to 18 months for completion of the works and ongoing maintenance, the duration of which will be communicated by the placement of on-street signage and letters to residents at least 14 days prior to works taking place for each section of road(s). All closures will be night closures from 21:30-05:30.

D) DIVERSION

Local traffic diversion will be along Anchorage Road, Norway Road, Copnor Road, London Road, Portsbridge roundabout to A27.

HGV diversion will be along Burrfields Road, Copnor Road, London Road and A27.

A copy of the Temporary Order may be examined at the Information Desk, Ground Floor, Civic Offices, Portsmouth during normal office hours.
