The Portsmouth City Council (Copnor Walking Nativity) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) (No.142) Order 2019

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the roads and the lengths of roads set out below on **Saturday 7th December 2019**.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING (ROLLING CLOSURE)

From 16.00 to 17.00, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary. Roads will reopen when it is deemed safe to do so.

1. BATTENBURG AVENUE

Outside St Nicholas Church to Kensington Road.

2. KENSINGTON ROAD

From its junction with Battenburg Avenue to Epworth Road. (The procession will process through College Park from and to Kensington Road.)

3. EPWORTH ROAD

From its junction with Kensington Road to the junction of Copnor road, outside Copnor Methodist Church.

REASON FOR THE ORDER

The above restrictions are necessary for the safe passage of the Copnor Walking Nativity.

DIVERSION

A rolling road closure will be in place. Traffic will be diverted ahead of the parade or will follow the parade and roads will be re-opened when considered safe to do so.
