**The Portsmouth City Council (Tipner Lake Coastal Defence Scheme) (Byway Open to All Traffic) (No. 20) Temporary Order 2017**

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14 (1)(a), Section 15 (1) (a), Section 15 (3) and (5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **1<sup>st</sup> October 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE TO PEDESTRIANS AND VEHICLES (INCLUDING CYCLISTS)**

LONDON ROAD COASTAL PROMENADE LEADING TO TWYFORD AVENUE From the junction of London Road to Twyford Avenue.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate the Tipner Lake Coastal Defence Scheme.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

In accordance with Section 15 (9) 3 (c) and (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), this order continues the previous order **The Portsmouth City Council (Tipner Lake Coastal Defence Scheme) (Byway Open to All Traffic) (No. 20) Temporary Order 2017** which came into force for 6 months from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2017 expiring on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 and was extended for a further six months from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2018. This Order is extended until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019, or on completion of the works whichever is the earlier to ensure public safety.

**D) DIVERSION**

Cyclists and pedestrians will be diverted from Twyford Avenue to London Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian and vehicle access to businesses will be maintained along London Road Access Road to Hilsea Lido.
