**Portsmouth City Council (High Street (Cosham)) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No.21) Order 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **27<sup>th</sup> March 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING**

HIGH STREET (COSHAM)

5 METERS EITHER SIDE OF RAILWAY  
CROSSING

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate the annual barrier overhaul at the level crossing.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

From 27<sup>th</sup> March 2017 for 18 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, the works will take place over 2 shifts between 23:00-05:00hrs each night 27-28th March and 28-29th March 2017.

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted via Portsmouth Road - Northern Road - Portsbridge Roundabout - Northern Road - Wayte Street - High Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained via station footbridge or Portsmouth Road - Cosham Interchange - Northern Road - Wayte Street - High Street and vice versa.
