**Portsmouth City Council (Raglan Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) (No.32)  
Order 2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **1<sup>st</sup> May 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING**

RAGLAN STREET

Parking suspended outside Kingdom Hall  
of Jehovah's Witnesses for 34m

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate the refurbishment of Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

It is anticipated that the work will take 4 months to complete. The order will therefore cease to have effect on 31st August 2017 or completion of the works, whichever is later.

**D) DIVERSION**

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
