Portsmouth City Council (Station Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.37) Order 2018

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **Sunday 22nd April 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

STATION STREET

From the junction of Commercial Road to Slindon Street.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate crane removal.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 22nd April 2018 for 1 month or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above the works are expected to be completed over one night starting at 03:00 on Sunday 22nd April and finishing at 03:00 on Monday 23rd April 2018. Closure will be in place for up to 24 hours only.

In the event of adverse weather works will be carried out over one of the following alternative three dates during the same timeframe as above: 29/04/2018 – 30/04/2018, 13/05/2018 - 14/05/2018, or 20/05/2018 - 21/05/2019.

D) VEHICLE DIVERSION

Eastbound: Stanhope Road - Unicorn Road - Alfred Road - Anglesea Road - King Richard 1st Road - Winston Churchill Avenue - Holbrook Road - Arundel Street.

Westbound: Slindon Street - Lower Church Path - Arundel Street - Holbrook Road - Winston Churchill Avenue - Hampshire Terrace - St Michaels Road - Anglesea Road - Alfred Road - Marketway - Hope Street RAB - Unicorn Road.

E) PEDESTRIAN DIVERSION

Pedestrians will be diverted via Zebra crossing point on station street and south side of station street footway then across at the junction of Slindon Street and vice versa.
