Portsmouth City Council (Anglesea Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.38) Order 2018

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **4th June 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, WAITING AND LOADING

ANGLESEA ROAD (SOUTHBOUND) From the junction of Bishop Crispian Way to the junction of St Michael's Road.

ST MICHAEL'S ROAD (SOUTHBOUND) From the junction of Anglesea Road and Park Road to White Swan Road.

B) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LEFT TURN

ST MICHAEL'S ROAD Left turn into Park Road from northbound carriageway.

C) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN

ANGLESEA ROAD (SOUTHBOUND) Right turn into Park Road from southbound carriageway.

D) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate works on the central reserve on the southern side of the junction of Anglesea Road and Park Road and on the north side footpath of the Anglesea Rd / Park Rd junction.

E) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 4th June 2018 for 20 weeks or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the works will take place on Monday - Friday nights between 20:30 and 05:30 on Tuesdays to Fridays and until 0800 on Saturdays.

F) DIVERSION

Vehicles diverted from Anglesea Road, Queen Street, The Hard, St George's Road, Museum Road to Landport Terrace. Traffic for Gunwharf Quays will be diverted around Cambridge Road RAB from St George's Road. Pedestrian and cycle lane access will be maintained.
