Portsmouth City Council (Stanhope Road / Willis Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.47) Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **7th May 2019** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING

Willis Road 07/05/2019 – 14/05/2019	55m from the junction of Stanhope Road. (Access for deliveries)
Commercial Road 07/05/2019 – 26/05/2019	At its junction with Station Street and Stanhope Road. (Buses diverted to stops on Stanhope Road.)
Stanhope Road 07/05/2019 - 26/05/2019	Southbound closure from Willis Road to Station Street roundabout.
Stanhope Road 19/05/2019 or 26/05/2019	From the junction of Edinburgh Road to Station Street. (Access for deliveries to Willis Road).

B) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND WAITING

Stanhope Road	Northbound only (except for buses).
Willis Road	In its entirety (except for deliveries).

C) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the Stanhope House development – crane removal and sewer connection.

D) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 7th May to 26th May 2019 or completion of the works, whichever is sooner.

E) DIVERSION

Willis Road/Stanhope Road: Traffic marshal will manage traffic using stop and go boards.

Stanhope Road southbound closure: Unicorn Road, Alfred Road, Anglesea Road, St Michaels Road, Winston Churchill Avenue, Holbrook Road, Arundel Street, Station Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
