Portsmouth City Council (St Georges Road, Vernon Bridge) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No.05) Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **30th January 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING

ST GEORGES ROAD

5M EITHER SIDE OF VERNON BRIDGE.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the installation of scaffolding and works to the railway bridge, followed by removal of scaffolding.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 30th January 2017 to 3rd February, 6th February to 10th February and 13th February to 17th February from 23:00 to 05:30 each night, or completion of the works, whichever is sooner.

D) DIVERSION

Northbound vehicles diverted from St Georges Road - Cambridge Road - St Michaels Road - Market Way A3 - Anglesea Road A3 - Queen Street - The Hard - B2154.

Southbound vehicles diverted from The Hard B2154 – Queen Street – Alfred Road – Market Way A3 – Alfred Road – Anglesea Road – King Richard I Road – Lord Montgomery Way – Hampshire Terrace – St Michaels Road – Cambridge Road – St Georges Road.

Pedestrians will be diverted across Park Road - underpass - The Hard and vice versa.
