The Portsmouth City Council (Earlsdon Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No.51) Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **13th August 2016** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING

EARLSDON STREET

From the junction of Middle Street to the junction of Melbourne Place.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

The Order is required to facilitate access to air conditioning units using a crane.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

The Order will be in operation for 3 months for completion of the works and ongoing maintenance. Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be in place for no longer than 3 weekends + 2 if any issues with weather on the day.

D) DIVERSION

Vehicle diversion will be along Middle Street and Melbourne place and vice versa.
Pedestrian walkway to be created around the site using pedestrian barrier.
