Portsmouth City Council (St Michael's Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) (No.51) Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **26th May 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING

ST MICHAEL'S ROAD

From the junction of Hampshire Terrace (opposite Wiltshire Street) for a distance of approximately 50m northbound to the pedestrian crossing on St Michael's Road.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate scaffolding works.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 26th May 2017 for 18 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. There will be a maximum of 20 closures required, the duration of which will be notified by the placement of signs 14 days in advance of each period of works.

D) DIVERSION

Vehicles diverted from Hampshire Terrace, Landport Terrace, Museum Road to Cambridge Junction and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
