Portsmouth City Council (Landport Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.58) Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991.

The Order comes into operation from **20th May 2019** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

LANDPORT STREET

Phase 1 - From the junction of Arundel Street to the junction of Buriton Street.

Phase 2 - From the junction of Buriton Street to the junction of Crasswell Street.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate trial hole works prior to mains replacement works.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 20th May 2019 for 1 week or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, works will take place between 0800 to 1600 in two phases.

D) DIVERSION

Phase 1: Vehicles diverted from Buriton Street and Crasswell Street.

Phase 2: Vehicles diverted from Landport Street, Crasswell Street, Charles Street, Alexandra Road, Lake Road, Holbrook Road, Arundel Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
