The Portsmouth City Council (D-Day 75 Memorial Service) (Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.61) Temporary Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994.

The Order comes into operation from **6th June 2019** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, WAITING AND LOADING

SOUTH PARADE	From its junction with Clarendon Road to St Helens Parade.
ST HELENS PARADE	From its junction with South Parade to Granada Road.
BUS INTERCHANGE	In its entirety.
OCEAN AT THE END OF THE LANE	In its entirety. From its junction with South Parade to west of the entrance to Canoe Lake Car Park.
SOUTHSEA ESPLANADE	

B) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING

ST HELENS PARADE	On the northbound carriageway from its junction with Granada Road to the entrance of No. 11.
ST HELENS PARADE	On the southbound carriageway from 27m north of its junction with The Ocean at the End of the Lane.

C) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the D-Day 75 Memorial Service and replacement bus stop on St Helens Parade.

D) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 6th June 2019 from 06:00 to 12:00 or completion of the event, whichever is sooner.

E) DIVERSION

Eastney Esplanade - St George's Road - Eastern Parade - St Helens Parade - Granada Road - Clarendon Road and vice versa.

Roads will be re-opened when considered safe to do so or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout all closures.
