**Portsmouth City Council (New Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) (No.62) Order
2017**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **27th June 2017** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING

NEW ROAD

Phase 1: Opposite No. 88

Phase1. Between its junctions with Ernest Road and Shearer Road.

Phase 2: Opposite No. 267

Phase 2. From its junction with Northgate Avenue to outside No. 271 New Road.

Phase 3: Opposite No. 190

Phase 3. Between its junctions with Burleigh Road and Aylesbury Road.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate gas works.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

It is anticipated that the work will take 11 weeks to complete. The order will therefore cease to have effect on 11/09/2017 or completion of the works, whichever is sooner.

D) DIVERSION

No diversion. These phase of the works will be carried out under 2-way temporary traffic lights.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
