Portsmouth City Council (Race for Life) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Waiting and Loading) (No.64) Order 2018

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16A and 16B of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **7th July 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

AVENUE DE CAEN

In its entirety.

CLARENCE ESPLANADE

From its junction with Jack Cockerill Way (west of its entrance to Pyramids car park) to east of the D-Day car park entrance.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the Race for Life and Pretty Muddy events.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 0700 on 7th July 2018 until 1500 on 8th July 2018, or completion of the event, whichever is sooner.

D) DIVERSION

Vehicles diverted from Jack Cockerill Way to Clarence Parade to Duisburg Way to Pier Road to Clarence Esplanade and vice versa.
Pedestrian access will be maintained.
