**Portsmouth City Council (Isambard Brunel Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.65) Order 2018**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING**

ISAMBARD BRUNEL ROAD  
(SOUTHBOUND)

From the junction of Station Street to  
Greetham Street.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate apex removal and reinstatement works.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

From 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018 for 12 months or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, the works described above will be completed within a single 3 week period. The lengths and duration of the works which will be communicated by the placement of on-street signage and letters to residents prior to works taking place for each section of road(s).

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted eastbound from Station Street, Arundel Street, Holbrook Road, Winston Churchill Avenue and westbound from Stanhope Road, Unicorn Road, Alfred Road, Angelsea Road, St Michaels Road, King Richard 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Winston Churchill Avenue, Isambard Brunel Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained.
