The Portsmouth City Council (Portsmouth Revival Festival) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) (No.69) Order 2019

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the roads and the lengths of roads set out below on **8th June 2019**.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

From 00.01 to 23.59, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary. Roads will reopen when it is deemed safe to do so. Notwithstanding the above the roads are likely to be closed between 2100 and 2359.

1. CLARENCE ESPLANADE

From east of its junction with Pier Road to west of the entrance to D-Day car park.

REASON FOR THE ORDER

The above restrictions are necessary for the safety of participants when the highway is likely to be thronged.

DIVERSION

Vehicles and cyclists will be diverted from Clarence Esplanade to Avenue de Caen to Clarence Parade to Duisburg Way to Pier Road and vice versa.
