**The Portsmouth City Council (Moonlit Memories Walk) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) (No.70) Order 2019**

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the roads and the lengths of roads set out below on **Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2019**.

**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

From 21.00 to 23.00, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary. Roads will reopen when it is deemed safe to do so.

**1. CLARENCE ESPLANADE**

(From its junction with Avenue De Caen to its junction with Jack Cockerill Way for a distance of approximately 213 metres.)

**REASON FOR THE ORDER**

The restrictions are necessary to enable the Moonlit Memories Walk to be held.

**DIVERSION**

Vehicles will be diverted from Jack Cockerill Way to Clarence Parade to Avenue de Caen and vice versa. Roads will be re-opened when considered safe to do so.
