Portsmouth City Council (Race for Life and Pretty Muddy) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Waiting and Loading) (No.72) Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **Saturday 6th July 2019** and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING

CLARENCE ESPLANADE

From its junction with Jack Cockerill Way (west of its entrance to Pyramids car park) to east of the D-Day car park entrance.

AVENUE DE CAEN

In its entirety.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the Race for Life and Pretty Muddy events.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

From 0700 on Saturday 6th July 2019 until 1500 on Sunday 7th July 2019, or completion of the event, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above, the restrictions will be in place from 0700 to 1500 on each day.

D) DIVERSION

Vehicles (including cyclists) diverted from Jack Cockerill Way to Clarence Parade to Duisburg Way to Pier Road to Clarence Esplanade and vice versa.
Pedestrian access will be maintained.
