**Portsmouth City Council (Eastern Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving, Loading and Waiting) (No.73) Order 2018**

Notice is hereby given that Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation from **30<sup>th</sup> July 2018** and the effect will be as follows:-

**A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, LOADING AND WAITING**

EASTERN ROAD SOUTHBOUND                      From the junction of Anchorage Road to Tangier Road.

BURRFIELDS ROAD EASTBOUND                      From the junction of Eastern Road to Dundas Lane.

**B) REASON FOR THE ORDER**

To facilitate carriageway trench reinstatement works.

**C) DURATION OF THE ORDER**

From 30th July 2018 for 1 week or completion of the works, whichever is sooner. Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be in place for no longer than 2 nights between 22:00 to 05:00, as advised by advance on-street signage.

**D) DIVERSION**

Vehicles diverted from Eastern Road, Anchorage Road, Robinson Way, Dundas Lane, Burrfields Road to A288 (Copnor Road, Baffins Road and Milton Road) and vice versa. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
