The Portsmouth City Council (Great Get Together) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) (No.76) Order 2019

Portsmouth City Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the roads and the lengths of roads set out below on **Sunday 23rd June 2019**.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING (ROLLING CLOSURE)

From 11.30 to 13.30, or at the discretion of the Chief Constable of Hampshire Constabulary. Roads will reopen when it is deemed safe to do so.

1. TRAFALGAR PLACE

From Fratton Community Centre to its junction with Clive Road.

2. CLIVE ROAD

From its junction with Trafalgar Place to its junction with Guildford Road.

3. GUILDFORD ROAD

From its junction with Clive Road its junction with Alver Road.

4. ALVER ROAD

From its junction with Guildford Road to its junction with Olinda Street.

5. OLINDA STREET

From its junction with Alver Road to its junction with Forton Road.

6. WOODLAND STREET

From south of No. 8 to its southern dead end.

REASON FOR THE ORDER

The above restrictions are necessary for the safe passage of the Great Get Together event.

DIVERSION

A rolling road closure will be in place. Traffic will follow the parade and roads will be re-opened when considered safe to do so.
