THE PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL (ENFORCEMENT CAMERAS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND WAITING) (NO.79) ORDER 2018

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council intends to make the above Order under Section 14(1) and Section 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order will come into operation on 20th August 2018 and the effect will be as follows:-

A) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND WAITING

No vehicle shall wait or stand at any time in any road or length of road in the City of Portsmouth where, at the time, vehicular parking is restricted to facilitate the installation, maintenance and removal of cameras for enforcement purposes.

B) REASON FOR THE ORDER

To facilitate the installation, maintenance and removal of cameras for enforcement purposes wherever this may be in progress.

C) DURATION OF THE ORDER

The works will be carried out in sections, the lengths and duration of which will be communicated by the placement of on-street signage, as required, and letters to residents prior to works taking place for each section of road(s). In accordance with Section 15 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), Portsmouth City Council (PCC) are satisfied that the execution of the programme of works will take longer than 18 months. PCC shall revoke the order as soon as the works are complete.

D) VEHICLE DIVERSION ROUTE

None required.
